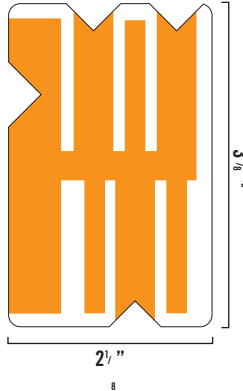


SKELETON KEY STOWAWAY HOLDER INSTRUCTIONS



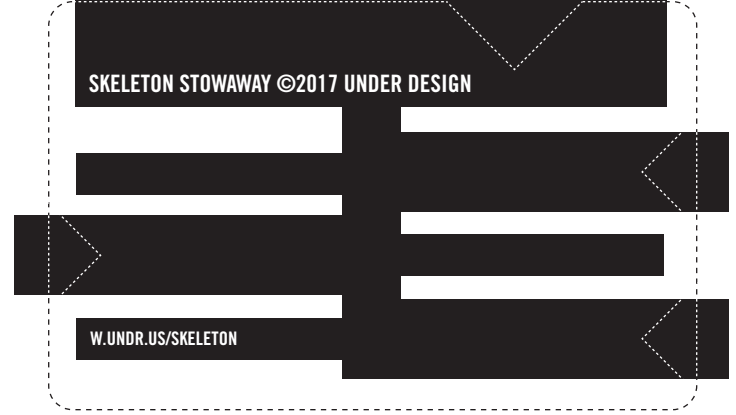
- Download this PDF from this short URL: <http://w.undr.us/skeleton> and print on a colorful sheet of 8.5"x11" 60 lb. copier paper.
- Cut the page into quarters, along the solid lines on the print.
- Fold each stowaway quarter in half, along the dotted line. With the black side facing up cut out the black area using good scissors or an hobby blade ensuring you cut through both sides of the paper. You should end up with 2 folded slips of paper, all shaped like the illustration to the right.
- Laminate the resulting pieces of paper, making sure they remain folded, keeping 1/2" minimum distance from each other or the sides. Run it through the laminator twice, to ensure a good seal. You want to see the lamination touch itself in the channels we cut, and all along the outside of the paper.
- Cut each slip out of the laminate along the dashed lines. Make 2 straight cuts along the dashed lines first. Then trim the ends just beyond the laminate seal to credit card size (3 3/8"), and finally cut out the thumb tabs.
- You should be able to slide a small set of lock picks into each card, then into your wallet. Friction should be enough to keep the picks in your wallet under most circumstances, but YMMV.
- Lockpick sets may be illegal to carry in your state. They'll have to prove intent, but these may get you past your next obstacle. Lockpicking is a skill that requires practice. Do not assume you can pick any lock merely because you carry this set of tools. The Police Statement Card should also be laminated and carried with these tools as a Rights Reminder.

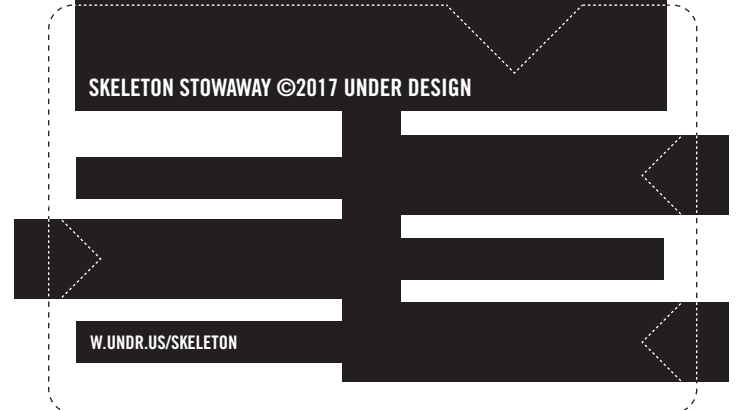
- CUT ON DASHES TO 2 1/8" x 3 3/8"

STATEMENT FOR POLICE

My Rights: ① Silence ② I can say "No" if the police ask permission to search me or my things. Saying "No" does not mean I have something to hide. ③ I can leave unless I am being detained or arrested. ④ If I am being detained or arrested, I have the right to know why, and a right to speak privately to a lawyer without delay - even if I can't afford to pay. ⑤ I can only be strip-searched in private by officers of the same sex. ⑥ I have the right to know a police officer's name and badge number. ⑦ I can report a police officer who abuses me, swears at me, or violates my rights.

*Officer,
If I am under arrest or being detained, please tell me so. If I am free to go, please tell me so. If I am not free to go, please tell me why. I wish to exercise all my legal rights including my right to silence and my right to speak to a lawyer before I say anything to you. I do not consent to be searched. I wish to be released without delay. please do not ask me questions, because I will not willingly talk to you until I speak to a lawyer.
Thank you for respecting my rights.*
